#### INDEPENDENT AUDITORS' REPORT TO THE MEMBERS OF R.C.A. LIMITED

#### Report on the Financial Statements

We have audited the accompanying financial statements of R. C. A. Limited ("the Company"), which comprise the Balance Sheet as at March 31, 2013, the Statement of Profit and Loss and Cash Flow Statement for the year then ended, and a summary of significant accounting policies and other explanatory information.

#### Management's responsibility for the financial statements

Management is responsible for the preparation of these financial statements that give a true and fair view of the financial position, financial performance and cash flows of the Company in accordance with the Accounting Standards referred to in sub-section (3C) of section 211 of the Companies Act, 1956 ("the Act"). This responsibility includes the design, implementation and maintenance of internal control relevant to the preparation and presentation of the financial statements that give a true and fair view and are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

#### Auditor's responsibility

Our responsibility is to express an opinion on these financial statements based on our audit. We conducted our audit in accordance with the Standards on Auditing issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India. Those Standards require that we comply with ethical requirements and plan and perform the audit to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial statements are free from material misstatement.

An audit involves performing procedures to obtain audit evidence about the amounts and disclosures in the financial statements. The procedures selected depend on the auditor's judgment, including the assessment of the risks of material misstatement of the financial statements, whether due to fraud or error. In making those risk assessments, the auditor considers internal control relevant to the Company's preparation and fair presentation of the financial statements in order to design audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances. An audit also includes evaluating the appropriateness of accounting policies used and the reasonableness of the accounting estimates made by management, as well as evaluating the overall presentation of the financial statements.

We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our audit opinion.

#### Opinior

In our opinion and to the best of our information and according to the explanations given to us, the financial statements give the information required by the Act in the manner so required and give a true and fair view in conformity with the accounting principles generally accepted in India:

- (a) in the case of the Balance Sheet, of the state of affairs of the Company as at March 31, 2013;
- (b) in the case of the Statement of Profit and Loss, of the PROFIT for the year ended on that date; and
- (c) in the case of the Cash Flow Statement, of the cash flows for the year ended on that date.

#### Report on other Legal and Regulatory requirements

- As required by the Companies (Auditor's Report) Order, 2003 ("the Order") issued by the Central Government of India in terms of sub-section (4A) of section 227 of the Act, we give in the Annexure a statement on the matters specified in paragraphs 4 and 5 of the Order
- 2. As required by section 227(3) of the Act, we report that:
  - a) we have obtained all the information and explanations which to the best of our knowledge and belief were necessary for the purpose of our audit;
  - b) in our opinion proper books of account as required by law have been kept by the Company so far as appears from our examination of those books;
  - c) the Balance Sheet, Statement of Profit and Loss, and Cash Flow Statement dealt with by this Report are in agreement with the books of account.
  - d) in our opinion, the Balance Sheet, Statement of Profit and Loss, and Cash Flow Statement comply with the Accounting Standards referred to in subsection (3C) of section 211 of the Companies Act, 1956 except as follows:
    - Note under Note No.9 regarding non-provision for diminution in the value of investments amounting to ₹ 46,45,085/- which is not in accordance with the accounting standard 13 issued by the Companies (Accounting Standard) Rules, 2006;
    - Note No.19.1 regarding non-adherence to the provisions of accounting standard 15 (Revised) issued by the Companies (Accounting Standard) Rules, 2006 for creating provision for Employees Benefits (quantum un ascertained);

We further report that without considering the effect of our observation made in para d(ii) above, the quantum of which is not determinable, had the effect of our observation made in para d(i) been considered, the profit after tax for the year would have been ₹ 22,075/- instead of reported figure of ₹ 46,67,160/-, Investment would have been ₹5,23,64,722/- instead of reported figure of ₹ 5,70,09,807/- and Reserve and Surplus would have been ₹10,91,13,693/- instead of reported figure of ₹11,37,58,778/-;

e) on the basis of written representations received from the directors as on March 31, 2013, and taken on record by the Board of Directors, none of the directors is disqualified as on March 31, 2013, from being appointed as a director in terms of clause (g) of sub-section (1) of section 274 of the Companies Act, 1956.

#### NOTE NO. 1 SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31ST MARCH, 2013

#### 1. Basis of Preparation of Financial Statement:

- a) The financial statements are prepared under the historical cost convention and are in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles in India and provisions of the Companies Act, 1956.
- b) All Assets and Liabilities have been classified as current or non-current as per the company's normal operating cycle and other criteria set out in the Schedule VI to the Companies' Act, 1956. Based on the nature of services provided and time between the rendering of services and their realization in cash and cash equivalents, the company has ascertained its operating cycle as 12 months for the purpose of current and non-current classification of assets and liabilities.

#### 2. Use of Estimates:

The preparation of financial statements requires management to make estimates and assumptions that affect the reported amount of assets and liabilities and disclosure relating to contingent liabilities and assets at the Balance Sheet date and the reported amounts of income and expenses during the period.

Contingencies are recorded and provided for when it is probable that a liability will be incurred and the amounts can reasonably be estimated. Differences between the actual results and estimates are recognized in the year in which the results are known or materialized.

#### 3. Cash Flow Statement:

Cash flows are reported using the indirect method, whereby net profit before tax is adjusted for the effects of transactions of a non-cash nature and any deferrals or accruals of past or future cash receipts or payments. The cash flows from regular revenue generating; investing and financing activities of the Group are segregated.

#### 4. Fixed Assets and Depreciation:

Fixed assets are stated at cost, Depreciation on all assets is provided on written down value method at the rates prescribed in Schedule XIV to the Companies Act, 1956. Assets costing Rs. 5,000 or less are depreciated fully in the year of addition.

#### 5. Investments:

Long term Investments are stated at cost. However when there is decline other than temporary, in the value of long term investment, the carrying amount is reduced to decline.

#### 6. Revenue Recognition:

- Revenue from sale of goods is recognized when significant risks and rewards of ownership are transferred to the customer.
- b) Dividend Income is accounted for on when the right to receive the same is established.
- c) Interest is accounted for on accrual basis except that income on non- performing assets is recognised on realisation basis as per prudential norms prescribed under Non- Banking Financial Companies Prudential Norms (Reserve Bank) Direction, 1998 (As amended).
- d) All other income is accounted for on accrual basis.

#### 7. Expenses:

All expenses are accounted for on accrual basis.

#### 8. Loans and Advances:

Loans and Advances are classified as performing and non-performing assets and provisions are made in accordance with prudential norms prescribed under Non- Banking Financial Companies Prudential Norms (Reserve Bank) Direction, 1998 (As amended).

#### 9. Employee Benefits:

- (a) Company's contribution to Provident Fund is charged to the Statement of Profit and Loss on accrual basis.
- (b) Gratuity is provided for on accrual basis. Gratuity liability is calculated at year end on the basis of 15 days' salary for each completed year of service.
- (c) The year end liability on account of Leave encashment is provided for on accrual basis as at yearend

#### 10. Taxes on Income:

Current Tax is determined as the amount of tax payable in respect of taxable income for the year. Deferred Tax is recognized, subject to the consideration of prudence in respect of deferred tax assets, on timing differences, being the difference between the taxable income and accounting income that originate in one period and is capable of reversal in one or more subsequent periods. Provision for Tax is made for current tax and deferred tax. The deferred tax assets and deferred tax liability is calculated by applying tax rate and tax laws that have been enacted or subsequently enacted by Balance Sheet date.

#### 11. Provisions, Contingent Liabilities and Contingent Assets:

Provisions are recognized in respect of obligations where based on the evidence available their existence at the Balance sheet date is considered probable.

Contingent Assets are neither recognized nor disclosed in the financial statements.
